GREATER ATLANTIC CANCER FUND

The Greater Atlantic Bluefish Tournament (GABT), now in its 31ST year, was started by John Dunn along with a group of local fishermen, mostly members of the Absecon Saltwater Sportsmen, as a way to raise money to aid cancer patients in need. At that time, we became affiliated with a national cancer aid group. However, in an effort for funds raised to be used for local cancer patients, we, in 2003 applied for and were awarded our own 501-(C) (3) charity status and adopted the "Neighbors Helping Neighbors Fight Cancer" agenda. We are a fully registered not profit charity, all volunteer organization with no paid workers. Funds for the organization are derived primarily through individual and corporate contributions, as well as entry fees from the tournament. Due to the ever increasing request for financial assistance from local cancer patients, we have added additional fund raising events, including raffles, dollar donation program, bingo events and a very successful gift auction.

We are committed to continue our "Neighbors Helping Neighbors Fight Cancer" program in the southern New Jersey area. We provide assistance and direct grants to patients in need to help with insurance co-pays, medications, rent, weekly bills and other expenses associated with their debilitating illness. Our mission is to help them through their difficult time. In conjunction with the Donny Fund, we have helped over 1,000 local families with grants totaling over \$1,000,000. We also offer an annual scholarship to a deserving radiological student at Shore Medical Center.

To better identify our mission, we have changed our corporate name to "Greater Atlantic Cancer Fund Inc." (GACF). The tournament remains the same as usual.

John Dunn passed away earlier this year. He was instrumental in the founding of both the Greater Atlantic Cancer Fund and The Ladies Invitational Bluefish Tournament. To commemorate John and the great work that he did for the community, both organizations have combined forces this year for The John Dunn Memorial Fishing Tournament.

As opposed to previous years, this will be a 1-day event; fishing during the day and the award dinner in the evening. We are also making this a family event with a buffet and music. This year participants can fish on boat, kayak, pier, jetty or beach. In addition, participants can fish for bluefish, stripers, and flounder. The awards dinner will be held at the American Legion at 4pm.

The entry fee has been reduced this year to \$150 for boats and \$75 for surf or kayak entries. Cash prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place (single heaviest fish) for striper, bluefish, and flounder in both the boat and kayak/surf categories.
